The RESO Data Dictionary & N.A.R. Policy



- N.A.R. MLS Policy 7.90
 - All REALTOR® owned or affiliated Multiple Listing Services
 must "implement the RESO Standards including: The RESO
 Data Dictionary by January 1, 2016"
 - Compliance with this requirement can be demonstrated using the RESO Compliance Certification process



- RESO certifies the MLS directly on implementation of the RESO Data Dictionary: http://reso.org/certification
- RESO certifications expire after 1 year






