## Wrongful Acts covered:

"... any negligent act, error, omission, misstatement, misleading statement or breach of fiduciary duty by the Association or Insured Persons in the discharge of their duties, including, but not limited to, the services by an Insured on or in connection with any Professional Standards Committee, Arbitration Panel or Grievance Committee or other committee ..."

Claim limit is \$1,000,000 per claim



## **Notable exclusion:**

"... any fraudulent, criminal, dishonest, malicious, or intentional act, error or omission, or any intentional or knowing violation of the law ..."

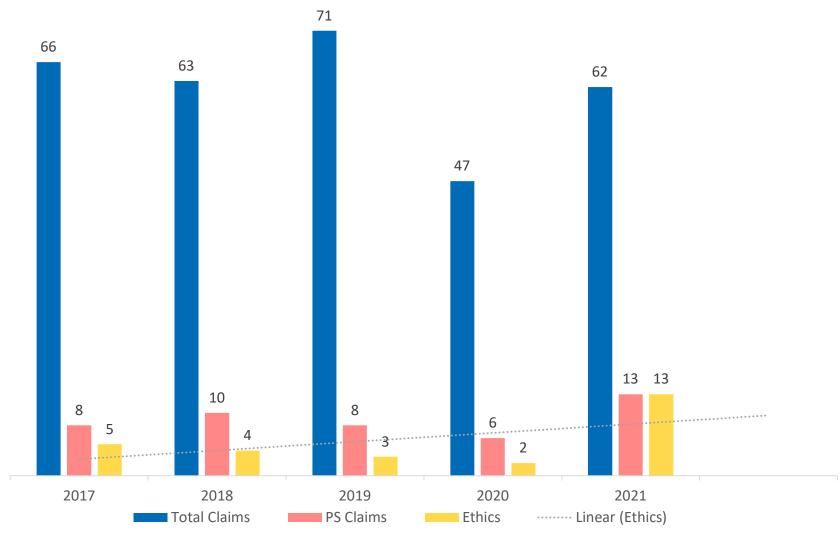
Pro Standards claims ranked #2 in claims filed for 2021

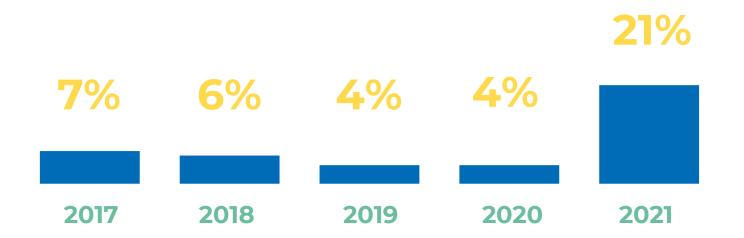




## Percentage of claims arising from ethics proceedings increased 3x since 2017

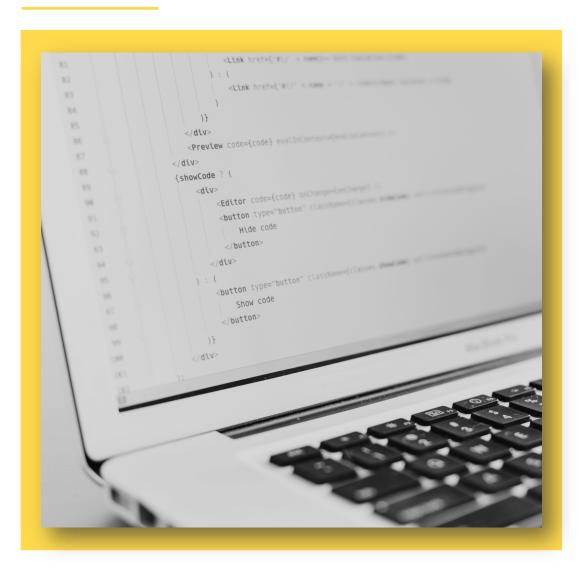

## NAR Insurance Program QUARTERLY TREND REPORT

SUMMARY: Association claims activity increased 32 percent in 2021 compared to 2020, with association governance, professional standards and employment making up nearly two-thirds fall claims. Nationwide, ransomware events continued to drive an increase in frequency and severity of claims on cyber policies.

### YEAR IN REVIEW

62 claims were filed as part of the NAR Insurance Program in 2021, with 63 percent of claims falling into just three categories:

Association Covernance 15 claims
Professional Standards 13 claims
Employment 11 claims

### CONSIDER THESE BEST PRACTICES TO PREVENT FUTURE CLAIMS:

### ASSOCIATION GOVERNANCE

- Provide an <u>annual crientation</u> for board members, which covers matters such as a director's role in overseeing the association's operations, and their fiduciary duties to the organization.
- Adhere to all association bylaws and policies generally, including when conducting board meetings.
- Engage a parliamentarian to ensure association board meetings are conducted properly and efficiently, especially where significant business will be decided.
- Consult local counsel for guidance on how state law may impact association governance.

### PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS

- Provide annual training for Crievance Committee and Professional Standards Committee members, with particular attention to due process and changes to the Code of Ethics and Standards of Practice.
- Ensure all professional standards matters are handled judiciously and in accordance with the Code of Ethics and Arbitration Manual.
- Use the sample forms and hearing scripts available in the Code of Ethics and Arbitration Manual
- Request local counsel attend professional standards hearings and review proposed actions before finalized.

#### EMPLOYMENT

- Periodically review the association's employment manual to ensure compliance with all applicable local, state and federal laws.
- Consult with HR professionals, such as NAR's <u>Strategic Association</u> <u>Management</u> team, for assistance with new or difficult issues.
- Provide annual anti-harassment training for all staff and board members, and timely conduct internal investigations into allegations of harassment.

- Consistently follow and apply all procedures in the association's employment manual, and be sure that the association's employment policies are consistent with NAB's Employee's mologee Caldelines which are a prerequisite for Employment Practices Liability
   Engance Coverage.
- Engage employment councel as needed, such as key staff terminations, and take advantage of the employment law resources and hotilee made available through the NAR insurance Program
