"That the Campaign Credentials & Rules Committee devise an electronic election process which allows NAR Directors from each Region to elect (from all qualified candidates in their Region) one candidate from that Region to put forward to the NAR Board of Directors' election for the position of RVP."

> - Govern Forward PAG Recommendation #6, adopted by the NAR Board of Directors November 15, 2021





The process must:

- (a) require candidates to obtain an endorsement from their home state association;
- (b) permit state associations to endorse more than one qualified member;
- (c) permit but not require each Region to have their own process for interviewing or recommending RVP candidates to the NAR Directors from their Region and
- (d) prohibit state associations and regions from establishing criteria for RVP eligibility that is different than the criteria set forth by NAR.

THE VOTING PROCESS





"... NAR will conduct an election in each Region whereby NAR directors in a Region may vote to elect its Regional Vice President candidate..."

> Campaign and Elections Rules Manual, Section M May 2022



 Prior to the regional election, Regions may permit NAR Directors in its Region to interview and endorse Regional Vice President Eligible Candidates.



 Beginning on the first Monday in October, NAR directors in each Region will have a two-week voting period to cast their vote.

- The electronic vote will be conducted on the Lumi online voting platform.
 - This is the voting provider used at the REALTORS® Legislative Meetings in May.
- Each Region will have its own unique URL; the platform will show only the Eligible Candidates for its Region.



 The Eligible Candidate receiving the majority of the votes cast will be deemed the winner of the regional election and will be placed on the slate at the next Board of Director's election.




 If no Regional Vice President Eligible Candidate receives a majority vote, a run-off election will be held between the two Eligible Candidates with the highest votes.






Monday, September 26, 2022

- Details will also be posted in the BOD Hub Channel.






Monday, October 3, 2022

- Voting platforms will open at 12 am ET.
- NAR Directors will receive an email with a link to their Region's voting site.
- The email will include links to a tutorial on how to use the voting platform and other resources.
- NAR Directors will receive a reminder email the following week.






Monday, October 17, 2022

- Final day to vote.
- Voting platforms will close at 11:59 pm PT.
- Lumi will report the results to NAR the following day.






Wednesday, October 19, 2022

- Results of the 2024 RVP Regional Elections will be posted to the BOD Hub Channel.
- All prevailing Eligible Candidates will be placed on the slate of candidates for the Board of Directors meeting in May 2023.







Thursday, May 11, 2023

- Election of the 2024 NAR Elected Officers will be held at the Board of Directors meeting in Washington, D.C.
- RVP election will be on the consent agenda.


